Dear Parent,

I hope this letter finds you all safe and well. As you are aware the school will now be closed up until at least the mid-term break. This is very disappointing for us all but unfortunately necessary, given the dangerous times in which we find ourselves at present.

The school building is open to supervise Key Worker and Vulnerable children and as the Minister has pointed out, as a last resort only. The safest place for everyone is at home until this virus can be brought under control.

The children's learning has now moved to Remote Learning and teachers will be working online daily from 9.15 - 3.15 p.m. They will be providing digital activities and support for all children via Seesaw. Teachers will be setting activities daily and where possible children should complete these on the same day and the work returned via Seesaw to the class teacher.

To further support your children all teachers will provide an additional Home Learning Pack to supplement packs children already have at home, these will include resources needed for activities, reading books, key words etc. These packs should be collected from your child's class teacher on Friday 8th January between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

All completed work should be returned to teachers via Seesaw.
